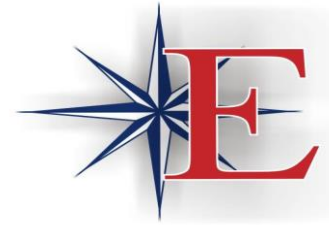

# SCHOLARSHIP FOR EASTERN STUDIES



## **CANDIDATES**

CANDIDATES may come from any of the countries of Eastern Europe, Balkans, Caucasus and Central Asia.

PREFERENCE will be given to candidates, who can prove their academic achievements or organizational activity and whose accomplishments would allow them to put advanced study in this specialization to good use in their own countries in various fields of academic or public life.

THE COMPLETE SET of documents should be submitted by e-mail [stypendia.studium@uw.edu.pl](mailto:stypendia.studium@uw.edu.pl) by 15th March 201... at the latest.

# SCHOLARSHIP FOR EASTERN STUDIES



## REQUIREMENTS

1. COMPLETED MA studies or equal to them five-year studies, preferably in the humanities; research work or organizational and practical experience in the fields of interest of the East European Studies are desirable.
2. AGE LIMIT: 30.
3. GOOD background in the general issues concerning Eastern Europe, Central Europe, Russia, Central Asia and the Caucasus.
4. PASSING GRADE in the written examination on general knowledge (subject matter as in point 3 above) and in the qualifying interview.
5. KNOWLEDGE of the Polish, English and Russian languages at a level guaranteeing that the student is able to understand the lectures and do the required reading – is essential.

# SCHOLARSHIP FOR EASTERN STUDIES



## THE SCHOLARSHIP COVERS:

a) Fees normally charged for foreign students who study at the University of Warsaw (ap-prox. € 5,000/year)

b) Scholarship for foreign scholarship holders being graduates of foreign institutions of higher education (1500 PLN/month).

c) Polish language course (during the 1st semester of studies).

d) Course in one of the region's languages (for the two years of the program)

e) Payment for a research tour in Poland (in the 1st year of studies).



# SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR YOUNG SCHOLARS

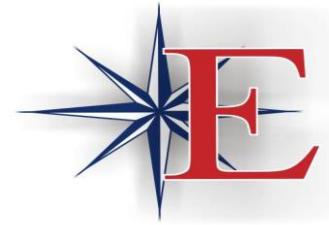


**Scholarships are granted for a research stay on Polish universities from September till June**

The scholarship is 1500 PLN per month. The costs of accommodation and feeding should be individually covered by the scholarship holders.

Place of application – counterpart Embassy or Consulate of the Republic of Poland. The application deadline is 1st March 201..

# SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR YOUNG SCHOLARS



## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. University diploma (4- or 5-year studies), preferably in the humanities: history, international relations, political sciences, journalism, sociology, ethnology, cultural sciences, social psychology, administration, management and law.
2. Age limit: 35.
3. General knowledge in the general issues concerning one of the above mentioned fields or similar fields, particularly in the 19 and 20 centuries.
4. Knowledge of the Polish language at a level guaranteeing that the student is able to understand the lectures and do the required reading – is essential. In an extraordinary cases there is a possibility to qualify candidates without the knowledge of the Polish language.



# KRZYSZTOF SKUBISZEWSKI SCHOLARSHIP



The scholarship holder will be given the opportunity to conduct academic research in Poland during academic year in collaboration with the University of Warsaw or with another Polish university, in the field of law, political science or contemporary history.

The goal of the scholarship is to promote democracy, human rights, the rule of law, and the respect of law in international relations.

The scholarship holder will publish the results of her/his academic research, in the form and according to the terms agreed with the supervisor and with the Foundation.

# KRZYSZTOF SKUBISZEWSKI SCHOLARSHIP



The scholarship and the research grant are open to candidates who hold a master's degree or equivalent,

or:

- have successfully defended their doctoral thesis (or have significant academic achievements)

or

- have accomplished works of significant importance in the public interest, especially in the area of promoting democracy and the rule of law.

Proficiency in foreign languages, particularly English, will be an important selection criterion. Proficiency in Polish is desired.

# KRZYSZTOF SKUBISZEWSKI SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship and the research grant are established to promote democracy, the respect of human rights, the rule of law, and the respect of law in international relations. The stay in Poland financed by the scholarship and the academic visit to Poland financed by the research grant will be related to the aforementioned goal, and will involve research in one of the following disciplines:

- Law (in particular human rights, institutional law, international law);
- Political science;
- Contemporary history.

The Foundation will grant one scholarship and two research grants for each academic year.

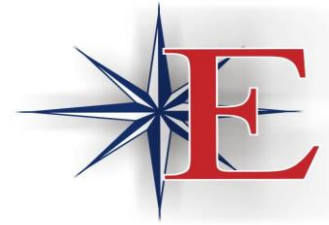
# KRZYSZTOF SKUBISZEWSKI SCHOLARSHIP



The scholarship holder will receive:

- a total of 28 940 Polish złoty (PLN), payable in monthly instalments, in the case of an 9-month stay in Poland; if the stay lasts for less than 9 months, the amount paid will be proportionally reduced;
- free-of-charge accommodation in Warsaw or accommodation expenses during his/her stay in Poland;
- travel costs for one trip from the place of permanent residence to Warsaw and back; and reimbursement of the cost of insurance covering emergency medical treatment in Poland;
- Preference will be given to candidates who are under forty years of age.

# LANE KIRKLAND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



**The following persons may apply for the participation in the Program:**

- lawyers;
- academic teachers;
- experts, politicians, employees at the government and local government institutions;
- entrepreneurs, managers;
- leaders of non-governmental organizations, cultural organizers and promoters of active citizenship;
- journalists.

# LANE KIRKLAND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

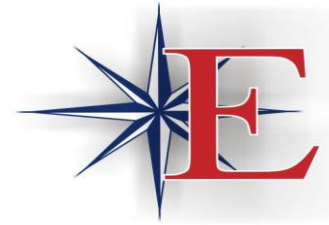


## Requirements are the following:

- citizenship and permanent residence in one of the targeted countries (Ukraine)
- up to 35 years of age (in special cases up to 40)
- holders of permanent residence card in Poland are ineligible
- Master's or specialist's degree
- professional experience of at least 2 years
- Polish language proficiency adequate to effectively attend lectures and seminars as well as to prepare a diploma project.

An option to study in English is possible for candidates only from outside Ukraine and Belarus (obligatory is B1 level of English).

# LANE KIRKLAND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



## **Research field should be in line with the following areas:**

- economics and management (business, NGO, culture, environmental protection, health care, education);
- public administration (government and local government);
- business administration;
- law;
- social science;
- political science and international relations;
- development policy and humanitarian aid.



# LANE KIRKLAND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

In September 2016 a new pilot path under the Kirkland Program called **Kirkland Research Program** was launched. It offers 4-months research and scientific internships for persons who already enjoy an established scientific position.

The scholarship program is intended for the period from the middle of September till the end of January (1 semester). The elements common with the Kirkland Program include participation in the orientation and preparation program in September, held in two sessions for the grantees (December and January), and - optionally - in other classes and workshops organized for the grantees.

As part of the Kirkland Research, the grantees are obliged to participate in academic seminars and work individually under the supervision of their academic advisors to eventually write a diploma project. If the grantee's academic article is accepted for publishing by his/her academic supervisor and the grantee presents effects of his/her work during the meeting of the grantees in January, such grantee shall be entitled to obtain the Program graduation diploma.

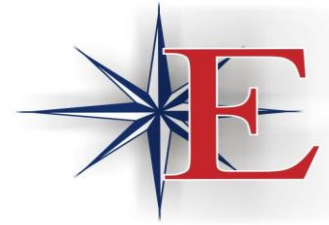
# THE STEFAN BANACH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME



Scholarships offered within the program include free both 2nd degree studies (Master studies) and 3rd degree studies (PhD studies) conducted at public universities supervised by the minister responsible for higher education.

The amount of the scholarship which covers the costs of accommodation and living is PLN 2000-2500 per month.

# THE STEFAN BANACH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME



**Master studies in the following fields:** natural sciences, technical sciences, agricultural, forestry and veterinary sciences, economic sciences, European studies and law – European law (50 scholarships per year).

**PhD studies in the following fields:** humanities, theology, social sciences, economic sciences, law, mathematical sciences, physical sciences, chemical sciences, biological sciences, Earth sciences, technical sciences, agricultural, forestry and veterinary sciences (25 scholarships per year);

# EAST EUROPEAN SUMMER SCHOOL



**East European Summer School takes place in Warsaw,  
1-21 of July 201..**

**The deadline for sending complete set of documents is May 20,  
201..**

The School is intended for participants from countries of Eastern Europe, the Balkans, Central Asia and Caucasus.

The School aim is to allow scholars to become acquainted with the latest research, new academic circles and prominent specialists in the field, as well as to become familiar with resources in Polish archives and libraries.

The School does not provide an opportunity to conduct independent research, but rather prepares participants for longer, future stays in Poland.

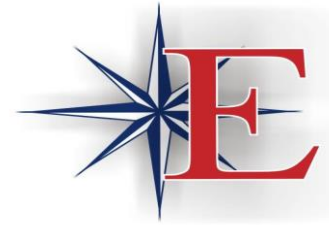
# EAST EUROPEAN SUMMER SCHOOL



## CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Participants with full rights may be only university graduates from abroad, engaged in their own academic research, under the age of 35.
2. Candidates are required to know both languages of instruction of the School: Polish and English, at a level sufficient to understand the lectures.
3. The preference will be given to candidates specializing in the field of the history and contemporary problems of Eastern Europe, especially in 19th and 20th centuries and collapse of the communist system as well as the transformation of the region.

# EAST EUROPEAN SUMMER SCHOOL



## SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Candidates from Eastern Europe as well as from Caucasus and Central Asia, who meet the School essential requirements, are eligible to apply for full or partial scholarships (depending on country of origin) to cover costs of accommodation, meals, lectures, materials and academic tours and partly - to cover travel expenses.

2. A request for a scholarship and partial covering travel expenses should be added to the candidate's application.

# UNESCO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

Program stypendialny dla młodych naukowców (do 35 lat) z krajów Europy Środkowo-Wschodniej i krajów rozwijających się realizowany jest przez Polski Komitet ds. UNESCO we współpracy z Ministerstwie Nauki i Szkolnictwa Wyższego.

O stypendia ubiegać się mogą absolwenci wyższych uczelni, którzy zamierzają prowadzić program badawczy w polskich publicznych uczelniach akademickich, nadzorowanych przez Ministra Nauki i Szkolnictwa Wyższego.



# UNESCO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

Stypendia przyznawane są na podstawie złożonych wniosków na okres od 1 do 6 miesięcy (1600 PLN). Stypendysta realizuje program badawczy pod opieką pracownika naukowego uczelni przyjmującej. Zgoda na przyjęcie na staż i objęcie opieką naukową powinna być potwierdzona przez opiekuna stypendysty we wniosku stypendialnym, który można uzyskać drogą mailową ([komitet@unesco.pl](mailto:komitet@unesco.pl)).

**NAGRODA im. IWANA WYHOWSKIEGO** – 12-miesięczny pobyt naukowo-dydaktyczny na 6 polskich uniwersytetach dla kandydata z zakresu nauk humanistycznych.

**STAŻE PRZY NAGRODZIE** – 4-miesięczne pobyty badawcze na 2 polskich uniwersytetach dla kandydatów z zakresu:

- nauk społecznych
- nauk ścisłych
- nauk ekonomicznych
- nauk technicznych

- nauk teologicznych/religioznawstwa
- bibliotekoznawstwa

# **CHARAKTERYSTYKA NAGRODY IM. IWANA WYHOWSKIEGO MA NA CELU HONOROWANIE ZASŁUG OBYWATELI UKRAINY W ROZWOJU NAUKI, KULTURY I ŻYCIA PUBLICZNEGO, W KSZTAŁTOWANIU I ROZWOJU SPOŁECZEŃSTWA OBYWATELSKIEGO NA UKRAINIE ORAZ BUDOWANIU DEMOKRATYCZNEJ UKRAINY – SKIEROWANEJ KU EUROPIE, UWZGLĘDNIAJĄCEJ NAJLEPSZE TRADYCJE DAWNEJ RZECZYPOSPOLITEJ ORAZ HISTORYCZNE, WSPÓŁCZESNE I PRZYSZŁE ZWIĄZKI UKRAINY Z POLSKĄ I EUROPA.**

Laureat Nagrody, kandydat z zakresu szeroko rozumianych nauk humanistycznych otrzymuje możliwość rocznego pobytu naukowego na kolejno odwiedzanych 6 polskich uniwersytetach, gdzie może prowadzić wykłady na tematy związane z historią lub współczesnością Ukrainy i regionu, stosunków polsko-ukraińskich, a także podejmować własne prace archiwalne i badawcze.

Staż przy Nagrodzie umożliwi ukraińskim badaczom z zakresu wymienionych dziedzin 4-miesięczny pobyt badawczy na dwóch polskich uniwersytetach.
