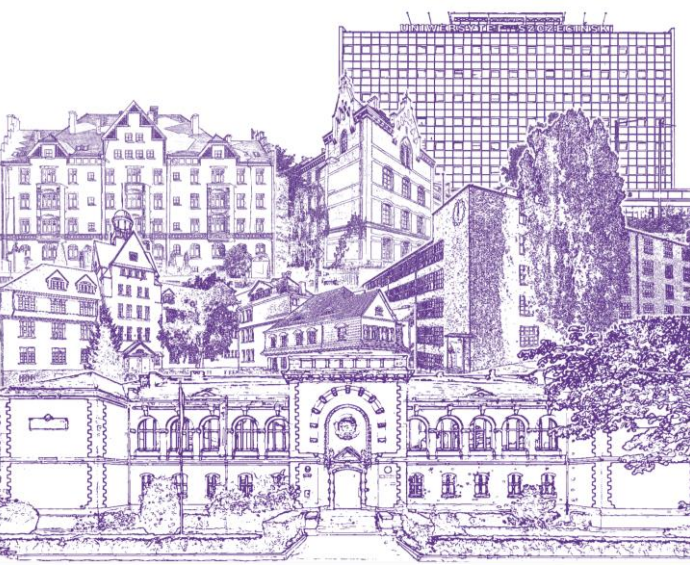

### Stage I

- Registration in the Online Candidate Registration system (entering personal data, choosing a discipline/disciplines) and submitting documents. **14.06.2021 – 13.07.2021**

- Information for candidates about the results of the recruitment procedure for the 2nd stage and the date of the interview - information after 2 p.m. (e-mail or text message, or a message on an individual account in the Online Candidate Registration system). **16.07.2021**

### Stage II

- Interviews online **19.07.2021 – 23.07.2021**
- Announcement of results **30.07.2021**

## Scholarship at the Doctoral School

- I and II year - 2050 PLN per month
- III and IV year - 3200 PLN per month

## Doctoral students can take part in various mobility programmes, such as:

- Erasmus+** – mobility for studies (1 or 2 semesters in one of partner universities) and for traineeships (2 to 12 months in a company abroad)
- PROM programme** – financial support for scholarship exchange of PhD candidates and academic staff (active participation in a conference or obtaining materials for a PhD thesis/a library query – in an institution abroad)
- Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange** – different research programmes, short and long term exchanges

The University of Szczecin also offers accommodation in student houses, with moderate fees.

Accepted candidates will receive administrative support with legal issues, e.g. visa, residence permit.
